

# INCIDENT SUMMARY

Multiple eyewitnesses reported observations related to a suspected abduction involving a white Dodge truck on the evening of the incident. Statements were collected separately and are recorded verbatim below.

## WITNESS STATEMENTS

### Witness Statement #1

**Witness Name:** Megan Sawyer

**Location of Observation:** Near the Board of Education offices

**Statement:**

Megan Sawyer was walking her dog during the evening near the Board of Education offices when she heard screams coming from the parking lot. Megan claims she noticed an African American woman being pushed into a white, Dodge truck by an unidentified male. She also noticed a grey-haired man sitting in the driver's seat of the vehicle. The truck left the parking lot at a high rate of speed.

### Witness Statement #2

**Witness Name:** Reese Conner

**Location of Observation:** Main Street (northbound)

**Statement:**

Reese Conner was traveling north on Main Street on the evening of the alleged abduction and had stopped for a red light. He noticed a white truck in front of him and heard what he claims was a man's voice through his open car window shouting, "Let Isabella go; don't hurt her!".

### Witness Statement #3

**Witness Name:** Kate Gage

**Location of Observation:** 17th Street (westbound)

**Statement:**

Kate Gage was traveling west on 17th Street when a white, Dodge truck drove through the red light and almost hit her car. She noticed an African American woman struggling with a black-haired man in the back seat. The woman broke free of his grasp and opened the door to get out; but the black-haired man shut the door and the woman screamed in apparent pain.

## **Witness Statement #4**

**Witness Name:** Joseph Maddox

**Location of Observation:** State Route 3, outside the city limits

**Statement:**

Joseph Maddox was heading north on State Route 3 outside the city limits when a white Dodge truck traveling at a high rate of speed ran him off the road. Joseph Maddox confirms there were three people in the car: two men and one woman.
